The most important aspect of your child's faith learning experience is fully **participating in the Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation**. As the primary teacher of your children, it is your responsibility to bring your children to Mass each week. The elementary students use the Pflaum Gospel Weeklies, which is a lectionary-based program. In order for your child to understand what is being taught in the Wednesday program and to participate in the discussions, it is important that your child attend Mass. Classes begin September 28, 2011.

Fees: \$40.00/child for grades preschool – 12th grade. Family Maximum: \$100.00. This includes students from one family in the RE, LIFE TEEN or J-Walking program. **This does not include the Confirmation retreat fee of \$50.00 or the book fee of \$25.00. (Separate forms for RE, LIFE TEEN, J-Walking and Confirmation must be completed.) Parents who are teaching an RE class, or are part of the Core Team for Life Teen will receive a waiver of fees for their children enrolled in any of the religious education programs. (This does not include the Confirmation Retreat fee or book fee.)

Scholarships are available!

Deadline: September 14, 2011. There is a **mandatory meeting** for parents of all RE students following the Masses on August 27 and 28. You may register your student at that time.

Elementary and Middle School Religious Education classes meet at 3:45 and 5:45. Note that Preschool meets only at 3:45 and the 8th grade TOB/T program meets only at 5:45. Please fill out the Religious Education form.

The high school (grades 9 – 12) program, LIFE TEEN begins at 6:15 and goes to 8:15 pm. Please fill out the LIFE TEEN form.

Confirmation (11th grade) begins with Mass at 6:15 followed by class at 7:00 pm. Please fill out the Confirmation form.

J-Walking (12th grade or already Confirmed juniors) meets in Room 29 at 7:00 pm. Please fill out the J-Walking form.
